The Programme

Accreditation (optional)

The programme consists of four professional study modules which, together with school based tasks, will provide a Leader of CPD with learning to accredit at Masters Level. Participants will be able to accredit their learning and gain a Post Graduate Certificate (Leading Professional Learning & Development) at Level 7 or they can use the university CATS to transfer up to 60 credits to a university of their choice.

Study modules:

Each module will consist of pre-programme reading, a face to face group development session and post- programme task and reflection.

Learning from each module may be accredited with Edge Hill University for 15 CATS points at Masters level.

Each module is a freestanding unit for accreditation.
