RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ART

- Submissions (Paintings/Drawings) can be in any medium including crayons, watercolors or acrylic.
- Due to Covid-19 pandemic our rules have changed temporarily.
- Students should produce their own artwork based on the given theme.
 For this year the theme is 'My experience during Covid-19 pandemic'



- All paintings/drawings should be clearly marked with student's full name, age, class, city, country and nationality.
- The Drawing/Painting competition will take place at each BSME member school.
- Completed registration forms are required for all final entries.





- To verify that this work was conducted and completed by the students themselves they must submit six (6) photographs of the periodic progress of their work, which consist of:
 - Phase 1: at the beginning
 - Phase 2: in the middle
 - Phase 3: at the end while working on the projects.
- Students should submit the evidence along with the final outcome to the mentioned email: lidia@srs.ae
- Samples of Do's and Don'ts are available.

- Each entry should be on A2 size paper.

RULES FOR DIGITAL ART

- Artwork should be in JPG format, 300 dpi, highest compression quality of 12.
- Artwork should be at least 2000px on the longest edge and not exceed 10MB.
- Artwork should not contain any frame, mat, or watermark.
- Artwork should be clear and in focus.
- You can use any app (Photoshop, Illustrator, Procreate, Artrage, etc...





RULES FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

- All photography must be 30X40cm.
- Only 2 images from each participant will be accepted.
- All photos should be clearly labeled full name, school name and telephone number of the student and the teacher.
- Completed registration forms are required for all final entries.


- Prizes given for first place and runner up winners of each year group.
